- ✓ All applicants must have a GPA of no less than 85 (unweighted).
- ✓ All scholarships require a minimum of <u>2 years membership in FCCLA.</u>
- **✓** Membership activities should be listed on the application.
- All scholarships (except for the Inez Murray-Janet Barber-Daisy Lewis Scholarship and the Atlanta Farmers' Club Scholarship) require applicants to attend post secondary schools that have Family and Consumer Sciences Departments and to major in Family and Consumer Sciences.
- **✓** All scholarships contingent upon *acceptance letter*.

Inez Murray-Janet Barber-Daisy Lewis Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend a university, college or technical college in Georgia.
- This scholarship may be used at a technical college or at a college or university that does not have a true Family and Consumer Sciences Department as long as the field of study is related to Family and Consumer Sciences.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$500.00 will be payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1.

Myrtice Edenfield Scholarship - \$600.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- Recipient must be from Region 6 or 7.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$600 will be sent payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1.

Janet McGarity -Barber Scholarship - \$700.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$700.00 will be sent payable to the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1.

Frances King Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- The president of the Georgia Association of Teachers of Family and Consumer Sciences (GATFACS) handles funds.

Atlanta Farmers' Club Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia or others as approved by the Atlanta Farmers' Club.
- Recipient may major in any field. This is the only state scholarship that may be used for study in a field other than Family and Consumer Sciences.
- Georgia FCCLA will handle Atlanta Farmers' Club funds as follows: \$500.00 will be payable to the registrar of the college upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1.

UGA Family and Consumer Sciences Alumni Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend the University of Georgia in the fall semester following the awarding of the scholarship.
- The scholarship is contingent upon receiving an official acceptance letter.
- Funds are handled by the Dean, College of Family and Consumer Sciences, University of Georgia

ABAC/FCCLA Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College in the fall semester following the awarding of the scholarship.
- Recipient must major in Family and Consumer Sciences or in a related field of Family and Consumer Sciences.
- Recipient must be an affiliated active FCCLA member.
- Must complete the ABAC Scholarship Application (<u>www.abac.edu/foundation/scholarships/</u>) as well as the Georgia FCCLA Scholarship Application.
- Funds are handled by the ABAC Scholarship Committee.

Allen-Childs Scholarship - \$250.00

- Recipient must attend a university or college in Georgia.
- Recipient must major in Family and Consumer Sciences Education major.
- Must be an active FCCLA member for at least 3 years.
- Must have competed in at least one competitive event.
- Must attend a minimum of two state or national events.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$250.00 will be payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1.
