### LET YOUR POTENTIAL SOAR

#### Membership Campaigns

The National Membership Campaign (iRecruit) recognizes FCCLA chapters for recruiting new members at the individual, chapter and state level.



The State Membership Campaign recognizes chapters for their membership recruitment successes.

**S- Students:** Each returning member is challenged to recruit one new member and use iRecruit program.

**O- Opportunities:** Events are offered to returning/new members that recruit, retain and recognize members.

**A-Affiliation:** Set a goal to affiliate your chapter before October 1, 2014. If affiliated by Fall Leadership Conference then members will receive a special ribbon.

**R-Recruit:** Increase your chapter membership by 20% and earn special honor roll recognition.

#### Adopt A Chapter

Option 1: Adopt a Middle School: Encourage middle level affiliation by paying one half of the chapter's middle level affiliation dues and mentoring the chapter.

Option 2: Adopt a High School: Help a high school affiliate by paying \$100 for affiliating the first 12 members for a chapter who has not previously been affiliated and/or mentoring the chapter.

Option 3: Mentor a Chapter: Assist a middle or high school chapter with chapter meetings, fundraisers, completing the affiliation process, Honor Roll, or other paperwork.
