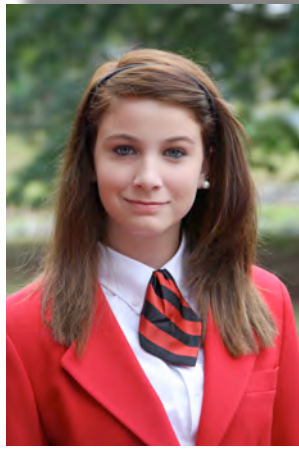


About Me
